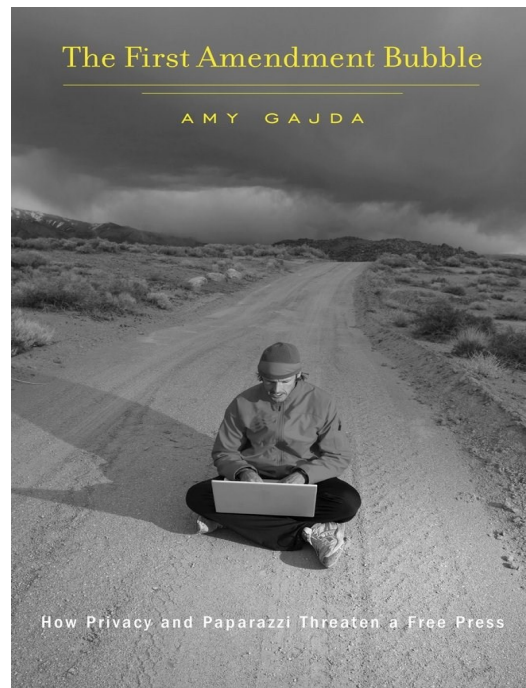

Professor Amy Gajda will discuss her book, *The First Amendment Bubble: How Privacy and Paparazzi Threaten a Free Press*, which explores judicial oversight of journalism news judgment.
